RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF  
A SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE BUDGET  
PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87

WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for equal amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Clayton in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2012 in the sum of \$4400.00, which is now available as a revenue from the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety pursuant to the provisions of statute.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the like sum of \$4400.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of the required certification, together with supporting documentation, be filed in the office of the Director of Local Government Service for certification.


